Fatal Morgana is found in mid 1992, by Louie Hatzimichalis and George Moschos. In no time Dimitris Roussos is added as second guitarist and Kostas Tsobanos (from Acid Death) on drums. Other two members join the band; Antony Arvanitis on bass and Stefanos Nikolalides on Keyboards and actually in the early 1993 the line up is completed. In this time begins the quest for the band's name. The initial idea is Fata Morgana but in order for the listeners not only connect the name with the same-titled Fates Warning' song they added the letter L and Fatal Morgana are born!

Basic inspiration for the name has also been the film "Excalibur" and especially the mystical sorceress Morgan lafey. From now on they work intensively over their first compositions. A year later they have written four songs, so in the middle of 1994 they enter the studio for recording. Because of the low budget they decide to record only the two of the four songs, unfortunately leaving behind "Mayhem's Prelude" and "Memorial In Epitaph", which one can barely find today only in rehearsal form!

After completing the recordings and with the really great help of Coti Kyriakos in "Praxis Studios" -who takes on the production and also plays most of the keyboards' parts- at the beginning of 1995 the demo is finally released. It takes rave reviews all over the world and everyone talks about one of the best new Hellenic progressive/power metal bands. This is why in Hellenic Metal Hammer is announced as demo of the month with dithyrambic comments!

In 1995 Fatal Morgana give several live shows in Greece, with Nightfall in "An" Club and support Stratovarius being the most important event. During the gigs the band asks for Mike Vazeos (Brainfade) help, as Kostas Tsobanos leaves the band due to his commitment with Acid Death.....
